## REGISTRATION

Register early to ensure your child's space in camp! Families registering more than one child should complete a separate form for each child. Forms are available online at [www.corcoran.org/campcreativity](http://www.corcoran.org/campcreativity). Payment in full, including tuition and \$35 registration fee, is due at the time of registration. No adjustments will be made for camper absences.

The registration fee of \$35 is a non-refundable fee per camper. This fee is waived for Family Members of the Corcoran Gallery of Art. Your membership number must be provided at the time of registration in order to take advantage of this benefit. ## WAYS TO REGISTER

**Online.** Beginning in March 2010, Camp Creativity will accept online registrations with payment by credit card. Please visit [www.corcoran.org/campcreativity](http://www.corcoran.org/campcreativity) to submit your child's registration using our secure website.

**Fax.** For fax registration with payment by credit card, please complete this registration form and fax it to (202) 639-1821.

**Mail.** Registrations with payment by check or credit card can be mailed to the Office of the Registrar, Corcoran College of Art + Design, 500 Seventeenth Street NW, Washington, DC 20006.

**In Person.** To register in person with payment by check or credit card, please visit the Office of the Registrar, located at the Downtown campus at 500 Seventeenth Street NW, at New York Avenue. The office is open Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., and Thursday until 6:30 p.m. Please note that no registrations can be accepted at the Georgetown campus.

**Phone.** For phone registration with payment by credit card, please call (202) 639-1820 and have all required information ready.

## WAITLISTS

Once a session's maximum number of campers is reached, a wait list will be established. Waitlisted children are not registered and may not attend Camp Creativity or Studio D without clearance from the Office of the Registrar. If space becomes available, the Office of the Registrar will attempt to notify the first person by phone or e-mail. If there is no response after 24 hours, the open space is offered to the next person on the wait list.

## INFORMATION AND RELEASE FORM

An Information and Release form, available online at [www.corcoran.org/campcreativity](http://www.corcoran.org/campcreativity), is required for each camper. No child is allowed to attend camp unless this form has been completed.

## SPECIAL NEEDS

The Corcoran is committed to making art accessible to all. If you have a child with special needs who may require any type of accommodation or assistance in the classroom, please notify the Office of the Registrar at (202) 639-1820 at the time of registration. This information also needs to be noted on the Information and Release Form.

## SCHEDULE ADJUSTMENTS

Any changes to a camper's schedule, including adding or dropping sessions, must be made in writing to the Office of the Registrar by submitting an Add/Drop form, available online at [www.corcoran.edu/objects/pdf/addDropCE.pdf](http://www.corcoran.edu/objects/pdf/addDropCE.pdf).

## REFUND POLICY

All withdrawals must be submitted in writing to the Office of the Registrar. Refunds are processed according to the following schedule:

Written withdrawal received on or before May 30, 2010 .....100%  
 Written withdrawal received on or after May 31, 2010, but before the first meeting .....75%  
 Written withdrawal received after the first meeting ..... No Refund

Please note that the \$35 registration fee is non-refundable. Refunds and credits cannot be issued for meetings or sessions missed as a result of illness, personal emergencies, etc., except in unusual circumstances.

## CANCELLED AND RESCHEDULED SESSIONS

The Corcoran reserves the right to cancel or reschedule any session, or to change the instructor. If a session is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment, every attempt will be made to contact parents two weeks before the session is to begin. In the event that a session is cancelled by the Corcoran for any reason, payment will be refunded in full.
