CORCORAN COLLEGE OF ART + DESIGN ANNOUNCES SALLY WOLFE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The Corcoran Gallery of Art and College of Art + Design announced today the new Sally Wolfe Memorial Scholarship, a multi-year merit scholarship program. Established in memory of Sally Osborn Wolfe, who taught painting at the Corcoran College of Art + Design, the scholarship will be awarded for students entering in the fall of 2010 and will help fund a significant number of incoming freshman for the entirety of their Corcoran studies.

Selection is based on a combination of review of academic records, including cumulative secondary school grade point averages and SAT scores, and artistic talent. Awarding amounts range from \$2,000 to \$12,000 each year, with total awards equaling up to \$48,000 per student.

“We are honored and humbled by this generous gift to our institution,” said Senior Vice President Mariana Nork. “We are delighted that, through her legacy, so many students will take advantage of the exemplary arts education the College of Art + Design provides.”

“I was honored to have known her for over 20 years,” said Deborah E. Wells, Senior Vice President, Investments at Wells Fargo and a close friend who took classes from Ms. Wolfe during her time at the Corcoran. “I’m flattered that she chose me to make sure her wish of making scholarships available to the Corcoran College of Art + Design became a reality.”

The Corcoran College of Art + Design offers a comprehensive merit scholarship and need-based financial aid program for new students through a combination of institutional merit scholarships and grants, federal and state aid, and tuition payment plans.

Sally Osborn Wolfe (1921 - 2009) taught painting at the Corcoran College of Art + Design. Her husband, the late Winthrop Wolfe, worked for the government but was also an artist who did wood carvings and black-and-white photography.
