Students who are dismissed from campus housing or the College as part of a disciplinary process will not be

- II. Students who are dismissed from campus housing or the College as part of a disciplinary process will not be released from their Housing Lease and will be held responsible for all related housing fees for the entire academic year.
- IV. Housing rent is due with the student's tuition payment each semester. A \$250 refundable damage deposit is due before the student can move into his/her apartment.
- V. If the student requests a single apartment and one is available, the rent per semester will double.
- VI. No animals shall be kept in Corcoran housing.
- VII. The student will not receive an apartment assignment until he/she has returned a signed lease.
- VIII. It is the student's responsibility to be fully aware of all Corcoran policies and procedures at all times, and understand that policies may be implemented, updated, or changed at any time.
- IX. The resident must be knowledgeable of and abide by the Corcoran's alcohol policy. The Corcoran College of Art + Design DOES NOT permit the possession or consumption of alcohol in its housing facility, regardless of the age of the resident. Additionally, the Corcoran vigorously enforces all policies related to alcohol usage and will not tolerate the consumption or possession of alcohol by student residents.
